Genesis 6

1 Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them,
2 that the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they *were* beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose.

3 And the Lord said, “My Spirit shall not strive[**a**] with man forever, for he *is* indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.” 4 There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men and they bore *children* to them. Those *were* the mighty men who *were* of old, men of renown.



Genesis 6

5 Then the Lord[**b**] saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every intent of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually. **6** And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. **7** So the Lord said, “I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them.” **8** But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

Genesis 6

9 This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God. **10** And Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

14 Make yourself an ark of gopherwood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with pitch.

15 And this is how you shall make it: The length of the ark *shall be* three hundred cubits, its width fifty cubits, and its height thirty cubits. **16** You shall make a window for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit from above; and set the door of the ark in its side. You shall make it *with* lower, second, and third *decks*. **17** And behold, I Myself am bringing floodwaters on the earth, to destroy from under heaven all flesh in which *is* the breath of life; everything that *is* on the earth shall die.

Noah's Ark was big but not an impossible size for wood. Steel is a superior material for shipbuilding so a wooden hull will never reach the lengths of steel hulls.




Inside Noah's Ark

The ark was built with "gopher wood" and caulked with pitch. The passengers remained safe inside until the waters of the flood subsided, nearly one year later.

Tessarakonteres Greek warship (~200 BC)




~510 ft. —————

Genesis 6

18 But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall go into the ark—you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you. **19** And of every living thing of all flesh you shall bring two of every *sort* into the ark, to keep *them* alive with you; they shall be male and female. **20** Of the birds after their kind, of animals after their kind, and of every creeping thing of the earth after its kind, two of every *kind* will come to you to keep *them* alive. **21** And you shall take for yourself of all food that is eaten, and you shall gather *it* to yourself; and it shall be food for you and for them.”

22 Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did.



The pyramids were probably built about 400 years after the global Flood “reset” technology. It is reasonable to expect that the Ark could have been built after roughly 1,600 years of accumulated technology.
